Deputy Program Manager (PM) - Will: assist the PM in the oversight of and execution of the project; coordinate with and work closely with the subcontractor supporting the project regarding the design, implementation, and ordering and provisioning of the physical infrastructure requirements, the design and implementation of the AV solution component; coordinate with and work closely with the subcontractor supporting the project to ensure positions are filled with fully credentialed personnel; coordinate with and work closely with the subcontractor regarding financial matters, including invoice verification, request for funding, ODC expenditures, etc.; coordinate with and work closely with the CENTECH corporate leadership in all matters of financial project execution. A qualified candidate must have an **active TS/SCI clearance**; a bachelor's degree in a related engineering or management field, eight (8) years related work experience, a BICSI/RCDD certification and a PMP is desired.

AV/VTC Specialists – Multiple positions - will be responsible for the set up and operate AV equipment, connecting wires and cables, sound and mixing boards, and related electronic equipment. May also set up and operate associated lighting systems. Must have seven (7) years of related experience and an associate's degree in computer related field (or equivalent experience); must have **active TS/SCI clearance**; valid CompTIA Security+ CE certification. Must have experience in VTC Services on NIPR, SIPR, and JWICS; scheduling, configuring and troubleshooting Tandberg desktop conferencing; experience in service desk Tier II and Tier III support for AV and VTC incidents; and DIA/DISA training.

Network Engineer - Responsible for the installation, modification, repair and maintenance of voice, video and data cabling systems. Will be completing survey installation areas to determine work methods, tools, materials, etc. This person will install configure and support organizations LAN, WAN, and Internet systems or a segment of a network system. This person will perform installation and service of low voltage category cabling, fiber optic cabling, communications cabling, communication equipment and other various low voltage related systems such as Category 5, Enhanced Category 5, Category 6, Category 6A and Fiber Optic Structured Cable Distribution Systems. Qualifications for these positions include: must have three to five (3-5) years' relevant experience and an associate's degree in related field; three to five (3-5) years' experience pulling, terminating, low volt cable, fiber cable; three to five (3-5) years' experience with basic cable trouble shooting skills (access point skills desired); must have **active TS/SCI clearance**; familiarity with NIPRNet, SIPRNet, and JWICS, ability to lift up to 50 pounds without assistance, climb a ladder, and work in cramped spaces; CompTIA Security+ certification and a CCNA is preferred.





Client Systems Technician (Intermediate) –provide technical assistance to computer users; answer questions or resolve computer problems for clients in person, or via telephone or electronically; and provide assistance concerning the use of computer hardware and software, including printing, installation, word processing, electronic mail, and operating systems. Qualifications for this position include having an active TS/SCI clearance; Bachelor of Science degree in IT; related field and/or five (5) years of relevant direct experience supporting client systems, an IAT Level 2 certification; a CompTIA Security +CE certification, and a MCSA and Windows 7, 8, or 10 experience.



Client Systems Technicians (Senior) – Multiple positions - provide technical assistance to computer users; answer questions or resolve computer problems for clients in person, or via telephone or electronically; and provide assistance concerning the use of computer hardware and software, including printing, installation, word processing, electronic mail, and operating systems. Qualifications for these positions include having an active TS/SCI clearance; Bachelor of Science degree in IT; related field and/or six (6) to eight (8) years of relevant direct experience supporting client systems, an IAT Level 2 certification; a CompTIA Security +CE certification, a MCSA and Windows 7, 8, or 10 experience and an HDI Desktop certification is desired.



Help Desk (IT) Support Specialists - Multiple positions - provide technical assistance to computer users; answer questions or resolve computer problems for clients in person, or via telephone or electronically; and provide assistance concerning the use of computer hardware and software, including printing, installation, word processing, electronic mail, and operating systems. Qualifications for these positions include having an active TS/SCI clearance; Bachelor of Science degree in IT; related field and/or five (5) to seven (7) years of relevant direct experience supporting client systems, an IAT Level 2 certification; a CompTIA Security +CE certification, and a MCSA and Windows 7, 8, or 10 experience.



Cybersecurity Specialist / Information Assurance (Intermediate) - will plan, implement, upgrade, and/or monitor security measures for the protection of DoD computer networks and information systems; ensure appropriate security controls are in place that will safeguard digital files and vital electronic infrastructure; respond to Classified Message Incidents in a timely manner using current IA policies, procedures and regulations. Must be proficient in Risk Management Framework terminology, processes, characterization models, etc.; have a Bachelor of Science degree in information technology or related field; have five to seven (5-7) years of relevant experience in related field, have IAM 2 and CompTIA Security +CE certifications and an active TS/SCI clearance. The person in this position must have the ability to brief/work with DoD leadership and high level stakeholders.



Configuration Management (CM) Specialist - will provide overall computer user and network architect support services for the JSpOC mission; establish and maintain CM processes and procedures; maintain and control the baseline configuration and required metadata; perform quarterly verification and audits of configuration and documentation on 10% of the baseline; monitor and track process for baseline change requests; migrate configuration from Access database to Remedy; create, update and maintain drawings of floor plans, communication rooms, and rack elevations; and provide CSA information. Qualifications include: must have a Bachelor of Science degree IT or related discipline; five to seven (5-7) years of relevant experience in related field; an active TS/SCI clearance; and strong organizational, documentation and reporting skills. Would prefer someone who has in-depth knowledge of BMC Remedy and proficient using Visio.



Windows System Administrator - will perform Windows based issue resolution; interface with cross-functional teams and developers to support and resolve technical problems; provide system administration support including server installations and creation of VMs; perform administrative tasks in AD and DRA, troubleshoot problems in dynamic complex system for support of multiple mission requirements; manage, build, and install complex Windows servers; mitigate vulnerabilities via scan results and familiarity with AF and DoD vulnerability reporting such as Notice to Airmen, TCNOs, Mission Type Orders and PoA&M; perform data migration actions and assist with server and data migrations and provide status reports and support documentation. Candidates must have a minimum of three (3) years' experience as Windows Server administrator; demonstrated skills in technical areas to support data migrations and to assist with server and data migrations; the ability to analyze information or reports for compliance with policies/guidance; an active TS/SCI clearance/access; must possess both security (e.g. Security+ CE) and computer environment MCP or MSCE certifications before performing any work.
